166**BRIEFING ORDER**

On September 17, 2015, the Court appointed Preston Burton to serve as amicus curiae in the above-captioned matter. The Court directed Mr. Burton to address whether the Government's requests in its application to retain, search and analyze, for foreign intelligence purposes, b1, b3 [50 USC 3024(i)] after November 28, 2015, are precluded by section 103 of the USA FREEDOM Act or any other provision of that Act.

Mr. Burton is hereby directed to file his brief by 5:00 p.m. on October 29, 2015. The government may file a response no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 6, 2015. Any reply by Mr. Burton shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 10, 2015.
