
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With regard to the facility or place targeted herein, the said specified persons shall:

- (b) maintain all records concerning this matter, or the aid furnished to the FBI, under the security procedures approved by the Attorney General and the Director of Central Intelligence (or the Director of National Intelligence) that previously have been or will be furnished to the specified persons and are on file with this Court.

The United States shall compensate any such persons providing assistance at the prevailing rate for all assistance furnished in connection with the activities b3 per FBI b7E per FBI described herein.





8. In any application to renew the authority requested herein, the

Government shall provide to the Court:

- (1) (a) the number of communications acquired by the FBI pursuant to this authority; and (b) the number of communications acquired by the FBI pursuant to this authority that the FBI assesses are not communications of the targets of this application; and
- (2) for any communication acquired by the FBI pursuant to this authority that the FBI assesses is not a communication of the targets of this application, (a) the location and United States-person status of the parties to the communication, if known; (b) an assessment of how and why the FBI acquired the communication; and (c) a description of the handling and disposition of the communication.

In the event that a renewal application is not submitted, the government shall



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submit a report containing the above described information no later than the expiration date specified below.
