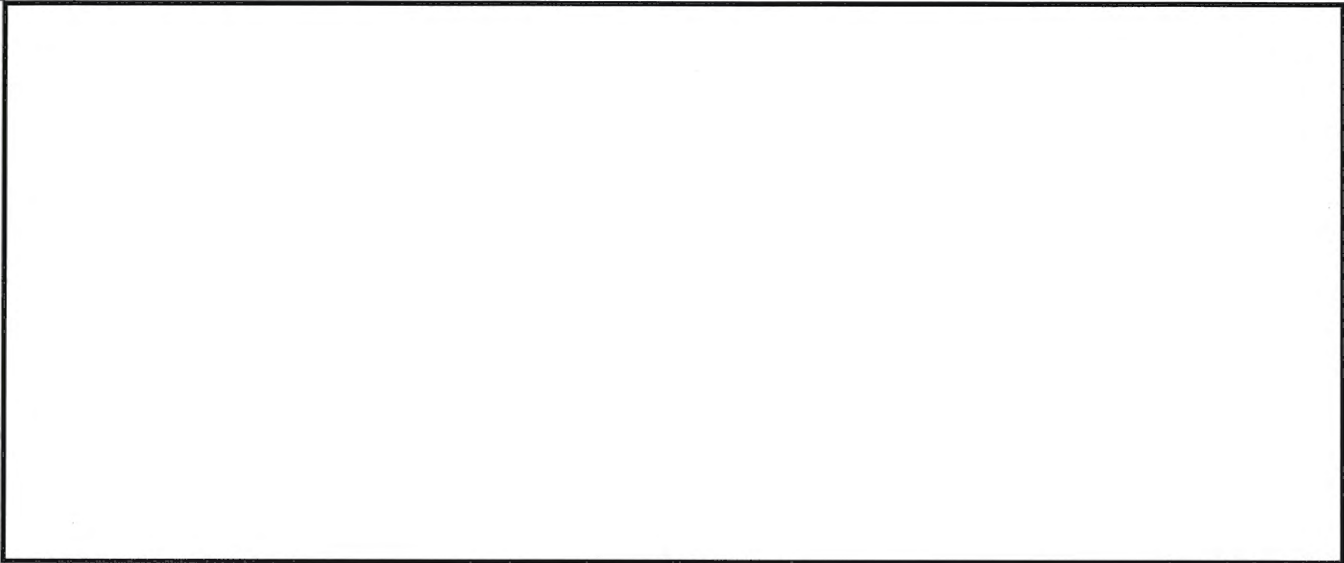

OF APRIL 23, 2018, APPOINTING AMICI CURIAE

~~(S)~~ By Order dated April 23, 2018, this Court appointed Jonathan G. Cedarbaum, Esq. and Amy Jeffress, Esq. as amici curiae (hereinafter "amici") in the above-captioned matters. The Court also determined that materials identified in Exhibit A to the Order are relevant to the duties of the amici, and that the provision of those materials to them was consistent with the national security of the United States. Accordingly, the Order directed that by May 1, 2018, or after receiving confirmation that an amicus has received the appropriate clearances and access approvals for such materials, whichever is later,


