Notification of Enhanced Engagement

When: Wednesday, May 24th, 7 a.m. – 2 p.m.

Where: 12th Avenue between Washington and Jefferson Streets.

Who: City of Phoenix, Human Services Campus and Community Bridges, INC. staff members

What: The City of Phoenix will clean and remove trash, waste and other debris from the area and require individuals camping in the area to permanently relocate. Refusal to permanently relocate may result in citation or arrest.

How: If you are in the area (12th Avenue between Washington and Jefferson Streets), you will be asked to move yourself and your belongings. Staff will be available to assist you if you are unable to move your belongings on your own. Unattended personal belongings will be collected and stored for 45 days. If belongings are not claimed within 45 days, they may be destroyed. You may collect personal belongings by calling 602-229-5155, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, or by visiting the Brian Garcia Welcome Center at 206 S. 12th Avenue. Identification is not required to reclaim most belongings, there is no cost to reclaim belongings, and you will not be cited or arrested for reclaiming your belongings.

After the engagement is complete, you will **NOT** be allowed to return to the designated area and camping on 12th Avenue between Washington and Jefferson will be prohibited. **If you're interested in seeking a shelter option, staff will be able to help transport you to an available indoor location or call 602-229-5155.**

Why: The City of Phoenix is committed to making the area as safe as possible for people experiencing homelessness and the residents and business owners in the area.

Notification of Enhanced Cleaning

When: Wednesday, May 10th, 7 a.m. – 2 p.m.

Where: 9th Avenue between Washington and Jefferson Streets.

Who: City of Phoenix, Human Services Campus and Community Bridges, INC. staff members

What: The City of Phoenix will clean and remove trash, waste and other debris from the area and require individuals camping in the area to permanently relocate. Refusal to permanently relocate may result in citation or arrest.

How: If you are in the area (9th Avenue between Washington and Jefferson Streets), you will be asked to move yourself and your belongings. Staff will be available to assist you if you are unable to move your belongings on your own. Unattended personal belongings will be collected and stored for to 45 days. If belongings are not claimed within 45 days, they may be destroyed. Notificación de limpiezas a detalle

Cuándo: Miércoles 10 de mayo, de 7 a.m. a 2 p.m.

Dónde: Avenida 9 entre las calles Washington y Jefferson.

Quién: Personal de la Ciudad de Phoenix, del Campus de Servicios Humanos y de Community Bridges, INC. (CBI)

Qué: La Ciudad de Phoenix limpiará y removerá basura, desechos y otros residuos del área y requiere que las personas que acampan en el lugar se reubiquen permanentemente. El no hacerlo podría resultar en una citación o arresto.

Cómo: Si usted se encuentra en el área (de la Avenida 9 entre las calles Washington y Jefferson), se le pedirá que mueva temporalmente sus pertenencias a un área segura designada. Habrá personal disponible para ayudarlo si usted no puede mover sus cosas solo. Las pertenencias desatendidas se recogerán y almacenarán durante 45 días. Si no son reclamadas dentro de ese tiempo, estas podrían ser destruidas. Usted puede recoger sus cosas llamando al 602-229-5155, de 8 a.m. a 5 p.m. de lunes a viernes, o visitando el centro 'Brian Garcia Welcome Center' en 206 S. 12th Ave. No se requiere identificación, no hay costo alguno, ni será citado o arrestado por reclamar sus pertenencias.

Una vez que se complete la limpieza, NO se le permitirá regresar al área y estará prohibido acampar en la Avenida 9 entre Washington y Jefferson. **Si usted está interesado en buscar un refugio, nuestro personal podrá transportarlo a un lugar disponible o llame al 602-229-5155.**

Por qué: La Ciudad de Phoenix se compromete en hacer que el área sea lo más segura posible para las personas sin hogar y los residentes y dueños de negocios en el área.
