



I have reviewed the proposed non-disclosure agreement and have discussed it with my

We have serious reservations about signing the agreement. Specifically, we are troubled by Paragraphs 7 and 13, which would preclude us from disclosing any information regarding the technology, beyond the results obtained, as part of our statutory or *Brady* discovery obligations, without first obtaining the written approval of the FBI. Paragraph 7 specifically precludes us from providing information about the technology "in response to a court order" without prior written approval from the FBI. The further restriction in Paragraph 7 precluding the use of the information in a search warrant affidavit could cause an affiant to mislead a magistrate and possibly result in the quashing of a warrant.

Additionally, Paragraph 9, would require this office, at the request of the FBI, to dismiss a case in lieu of providing discovery about the technology. We understand the FBI's concerns that revealing the capabilities of this technology could allow criminals to employ countermeasures to avoid detection. However, agreeing never to disclose the technology in discovery, even when ordered to do so by a court, without prior FBI approval, could place our prosecutors in a position of compromising their statutory and ethical duties. Agreeing to dismiss a well-founded case to avoid providing discovery could inhibit their duty to vigorously advocate on behalf of victims. As a result, we cannot sign the agreement as it is currently drafted.
