On this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2025, on oral argument on Plaintiff's Motion for KDOR to Maintain a Record of Changes to Driver's Licenses and Defendants' Motion for Sanctions. The Plaintiff appears by counsel Anthony Powell. The Defendants appear by Counsel Pedro Irigonegaray, and Ted Smith. The Intervenors appear by Counsel John Turney. Thereafter, Plaintiff withdraws his request to extend the temporary injunction until such time as KDOR provides assurances that it will keep the appropriate records. The Court denies Plaintiff's request that the Respondents keep a detailed, individualized, and personally identifiable record of driver's license changes. The Court finds that the equivalent of that information is already being kept by the Respondent. The Court takes the matter of sanctions under advisement. The parties will confer and present to the court several alternative days and times for the Court to hear oral argument on the summary judgment motions filed.
