NOTICE

Petitioner–Plaintiff Nizar Trabelsi writes to inform the Court of recent developments in this matter and to present an intended course for bringing this action to a conclusion.

On or about August 8, 2025, the United States removed Petitioner–Plaintiff to Belgium. As a result, Petitioner–Plaintiff’s pending claims challenging conditions of his confinement in immigration custody, *see* ECF No. 1 at 23–24, are moot.

Counsel for the parties are agreeable to filing a stipulation of voluntary dismissal pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). As a result, there is no further need for the Court to address the parties’ currently pending motions. *See, e.g.*, ECF No. 38 (Respondents–Defendants’ motion for summary judgment on Petitioner–Plaintiff’s non-habeas claims); ECF No. 45 (Petitioner–Plaintiff’s motion for discovery relevant to motion for summary judgment).

Before filing that document and causing the administrative closure of this case, Petitioner–Plaintiff intends to move the Court to vacate, under *United States v. Munsingwear*, 340 U.S. 36 (1950), its decision granting the government’s motion to dismiss Petitioner–Plaintiff’s claims sounding in habeas. ECF No. 50. Petitioner–Plaintiff anticipates filing that motion within 30 days.
