

District Judge Julia E. Kobick: ELECTRONIC ORDER entered.

The defendants' motion to stay district court proceedings pending appeal of the preliminary injunction orders, ECF [134], is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part for the reasons stated on the record. The plaintiffs' claims raising constitutional arguments—counts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of the amended complaint—shall be stayed pending resolution of the defendants' appeal of the preliminary injunction orders. Counts 6 and 7 of the amended complaint, which assert claims under the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 U.S.C. §§ 706(2)(A) and (2)(D), will not be stayed. In connection with those latter claims, the defendants are ORDERED to file the administrative record by August 27, 2025. The parties are further ORDERED to confer and file a joint status report by September 17, 2025, containing proposals for a scheduling order to follow. (Currie, Haley) (entered 8/6/25)
