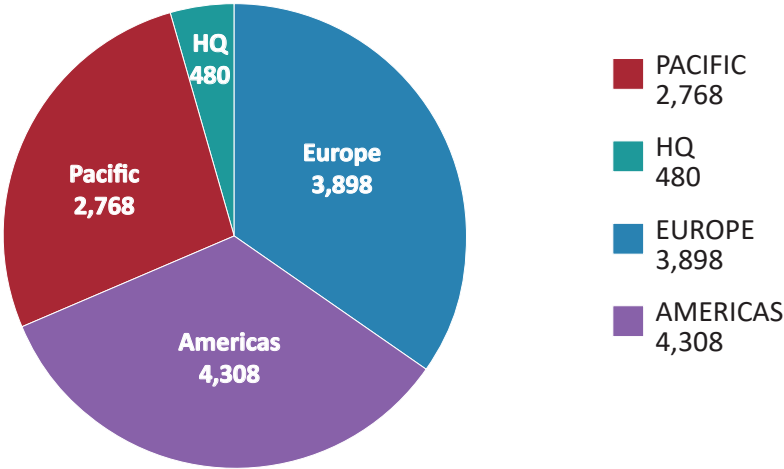

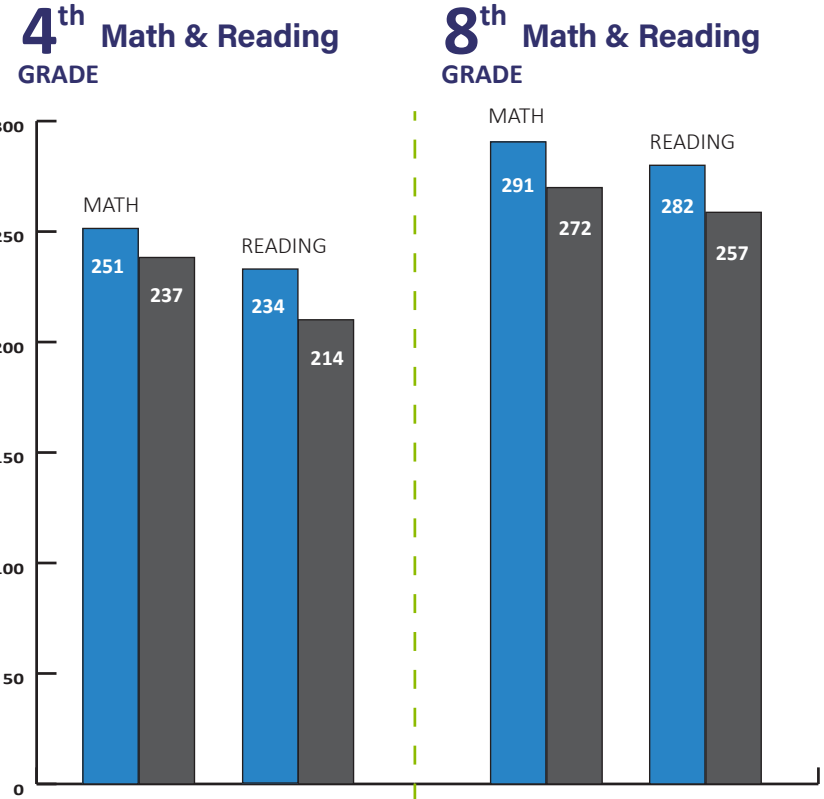
- 1) REDUCED ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS AND COSTS
