SUBJECT: (SBU) Revocation of Visa – Rumeysa OZTURK

(SBU) On March 21, 2025, in response to a request from DHS/ICE and the assessment from DHS/ICE that Rumeysa OZTURK had been involved in associations that "may undermine U.S. foreign policy by creating a hostile environment for Jewish students and indicating support for a designated terrorist organization" including co-authoring an op-ed that found common cause with an organization that was later temporarily banned from campus, the Bureau of Consular Affairs approved revocation, effective immediately, of the F-1 visa of OZTURK, DPOB: Turkey, Visa Foil Turkey, Visa Foil pursuant to authority in section 221(i) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. 1201(i). Due to ongoing ICE operational security, this revocation will be silent; the Department of State will not notify the subject of the revocation.

(U) The information in this record is confidential under INA 222(f) and specific biographical data about the alien cannot be shared in public statements.
