Hi Capt. Williams,

In response to the request below, I contacted CID, Detective Hanada, and the Patrol Division to find out how we obtain cell phone data. From the information I gathered, it's either from requests to cell phone carriers or by forensic equipment used by the Department. The public records request seems to focus on the data obtained through cell phone carriers, so I've divided the estimated expense into two categories, carriers and forensics.

Cell Phone Carriers -

- 1. Requests for data records/tracking information should be fairly accessible. I've received varying opinions on cost. In cases of emergency, it's no cost. For warrants, I've heard no cost and \$50. Traci can hopefully answer this and estimate time to pull records.
- 2. Officer time could be a challenge and not practical to determine officer time. No tracking (other than what might be documented in billing) on use would be documented in police report/warrants. Might be tracked on OT cards? Sounds like we use this service infrequently.

Forensics -

The accounting information for materials and services should be fairly accessible. Traci would be better to estimate time to identify expenses and pull paid invoices, etc. I recall some of the training expenses may have been paid with WIN \$, so we would need to contact the County. We've also used forfeiture funds. Below are my best estimates of types of expenditures:

- 1. Cellebrite Forensic Equipment Cost of equipment (one-time expense), software licensing/updates (annual cost), and travel/training expense for officer training.
- 2. Regional Computer Forensic Lab (RCFL) they have loaned us equipment.
- 3. Officer time would be less accessible. ProTeam maintains a log to track cases investigated. Detective Hanada might track cases.
