TOPIC:

Search Warrants

PURPOSE:

This order was generated to provide information regarding the requirements from the District Attorney's Office regarding the application of a search warrant.

Pursuant to the SIXTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT, Local Court Rules, effective February 1, 2002, Chapter 4, Criminal Cases, all members of the Hermiston Police Department will comply with the following:

4.025 Search Warrants

- (1) A request for a search warrant shall be made to a Circuit Court judge.
- (2) Prior to presenting a request for a search warrant, the applicant shall:
 - (a) Obtain prior approval from a District Attorney (or one of his/her deputies) who has personally reviewed the facts underlying the application;
 - (b) Provide the name of the reviewing Districy Attorney; and
 - (c) Verify that the search warrant application has not been presented to any other judge.
