INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN The Borough OF West Chester, Pa AND The City OF Coatesville, Pa

2011 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this_18th_day of July, 2011, by and between The City of Coatesville, acting by and through its governing body, the City Council of Coatesville, hereinafter referred to as City, and the Borough of West Chester, acting by and through its governing body, the Borough Council, hereinafter referred to as the Borough of West Chester, both of Chester County, State of Pennsylvania, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, this Agreement is made under the authority of Sections 202.0 Home Rule Charter Government Code: and

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement: and

WHEREAS, the Borough agrees to share with the City \$32,024.00 from the JAG award program: and

WHEREAS, the Borough and City believe it to be in their best interests to share the JAG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the City and the Borough agree as follows:

Section 1.

Borough agrees to share with the City a total of \$20,322.00 of JAG funds.

Section 2.

City agrees to the Borough of West Chester receiving \$11,702.00 of the JAG Program until the Grant is completed.

City agrees to permit the Borough to accept \$11,702.00.00 from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant.

Section 3.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against City other than claims for which liability may be imposed by a Civil Tort Claims Act.

Section 4.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against Borough other than claims for which liability may be imposed by a Civil Tort Claims Act.

Section 5.

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

Section 6.

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

Section 7.

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.

SUBJECT: Public Meeting on Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant

I respectfully request the Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant be placed on the Public Safety Committee agenda on August 9, 2011 for final approval by the Borough Council. The West Chester Police Department will be applying for a combined grant with the City of Coatesville. The Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant requires an administrator be assigned to oversee the grant process. The West Chester Police Department has assumed responsibility to oversee the Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant in the amount of \$32024.00. The City of Coatesville will be receiving \$20322.00 and the Borough of West Chester will be receiving \$11702.00.

The West Chester Police Department will be using the Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant towards purchasing a police server for the ICOP Unit and ICOP equipment. This program uses technology that will revolutionize our duties and responsibilities towards public safety and security. Over 50% of all crimes are related to a vehicle, and the ability to automate the process of identifying vehicles of interest has an immense value to our officers.

The City of Coatesville will be using the Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant towards purchasing general police equipment to supplement their daily activities. Complete lists of items are pending from the City of Coatesville.

Therefore, I am requesting the Edward Byrne Memorial Assistance Grant funds be used towards the purchase of this system. The West Chester Police Department is also applying for additional funds to supplement the cost of this expenditure.

I will be available to discuss this request at your earliest convenience.
