Project Title – Emergency phone/camera towers

Goals, strategies, deliverables, and plans - St. John the Baptist Parish Sheriff's Office is in the process of purchasing emergency phone/camera towers. These towers will be compatible with our new crime camera project and connect directly with our 911 communications system. The towers will provide some additional safety to residents using parish recreation facilities which may be in some isolated locations.

2010 JAG GRANT PROGRAM NARRATIVE

St. John the Baptist Parish Sheriff's Office is in the process of purchasing an emergency phone/camera tower. This tower will be compatible with our new crime camera project and connect directly with our 911 communications system. The tower will provide some additional safety to residents using a parish recreation facility which may be in an isolated location. St. John the Baptist Parish Sheriff's Office is always searching for additional safety features to be placed at our recreational parks and walking paths as they are constantly used by the residents of the Parish. In addition, the Sheriff's Office is also looking to purchase a mobile law enforcement license plate recognition system. This mobile camera system will also be compatible with our 911 communications system. The system will assist the Sheriff's Office in tracking and locating wanted or stolen vehicles.

The St. John the Baptist Parish Sheriff's Office is looking to purchase, install, and begin operating both the emergency tower and license plate recognition system by March 31, 2011.

As with past JAG grants, the tracking of all grant draw downs and expenditures will be handled by our civil department. Our Chief Civil Deputy Mr. Jeffrey Clement will be the person responsible for handling all accounting requirements of this grant. The Sheriff's Office uses a grant checking account that is separate from its general fund. This separate account allows the Sheriff's Office to keep the JAG grant separate from other grants and funding it receives.
