During such an emergency CAA could also interact with other federal, state and local authorities serving the community. CAA could also be an effective outreach tool for the Bureau in the Business, Media, Student & Community settings. Also, CAA could be active at the many Minority chamber of commerce mixers, student fairs and neighborhood associations all of whom would surely welcome your Bureaus promotional products, information & emergency information tips.

CAA would like to assist in communicating Scam alert tips from your Bureau, alerting the media and community about the current problems and trends. Telemarketing/Fraud information could be given to state agencies like Consumer Affairs and the federal's First Gov for Consumers. Both proactive web-sites alert consumers on current scam activities. Scam alerts produced similar to crime alerts for short TV segments would also help solicit more media coverage on fraud, scams and violent issues that present harm to the community.

CAA would like to meet regularly with similar CAA -like organizations from Sacramento Sheriffs Department, Sacramento Police Department, California Highway Patrol, OES and FEMA. CAA could assist your Bureau photographers with producing short videos to share with community organizations on Violent crime concerns and tips on Terrorism issues as well as Video commentary from yourself to play and hand out at neighborhood associations, and other community organization's meetings.

I welcome you and your staff's guidance and input to effectively design mission components for the CAA which would be a good resource for the Bureau. I am available to meet with you and your staff for further discussion and implementation.
