Dear Mr. Collins:

This letter is in response to your request for public information, which the City of Fort Worth (the "City") received on July 31, 2012. A portion of the information you requested can be released to you at this time. We understand that the Transportation and Public Works Department has already notified you that they had no responsive records. A copy is attached of the Affidavit of No Record we received from the Police Department because they were unable to locate the information for several items on your request. However, the City believes that the remainder of the responsive records may be excepted from public disclosure under the Public Information Act, T EX. GOV'T CODE ANN. §§ 552.001-.353 (West 2004 & Supp. 2006). Therefore, the City is requesting an opinion from the Texas Attorney General's Office (the "AG") concerning whether the requested information is subject to release.

A copy of the City's request for a ruling is enclosed. You may submit arguments to the AG regarding why you think the information should be disclosed to you. If you wish to submit such arguments, please do so within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice. You must provide the City with a copy of any correspondence that you submit to the AG. The AG will notify you when a ruling has been made.
