Dear Ms. Singh:

In my June 5, 2009 email to you, I indicated that the Government did not believe the Court's June 3, 2009 Order required the Government to complete re-processing by today of the Central Intelligence Agency Officer of Inspector General Special Review Report. I nevertheless stated that the Government intended to complete re-processing of that document by today. The CIA's re-processing of the document is largely complete. Given the need for inter-agency review of the re-processed document, however, we will need additional time to make a final determination as to what additional information, if any, may be disclosed from the report. We intend to complete the re-processing of the document, and to produce any additional information that may disclosed, by June 26, 2009.
