Dear Ms. Younger:

I am writing in follow-up to your October 30, 2003 Freedom of Information Act requests to Commissioner Arthur L. Spada and Deputy Commissioner Vincent DeRosa seeking records concerning MATRIX.

In response to your request to inspect and copy records concerning the MATRIX program, please be advised as follows:

- 1) Regarding paragraph 1, the User Manual is not available for public disclosure as they are protected by federal copyright laws and further are exempt from disclosure pursuant to C.G.S. Sec. 1-210(b)(5);
- 2) Regarding paragraph 2, a copy of the Memorandum of Agreement between the MATRIX Participation Group and the Institute for Intergovernmental Research, the MATRIX Privacy Policy, a document entitled MATRIX Frequently Asked Questions and Introduction to FACTS are attached. The agency security agreement is not subject to disclosure pursuant to C.G.S. Sec. 1-210(b)(3) and 1-210(b)(20).
