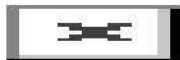

The Harvard Catalyst's Child Health Symposium that (b)(6) referenced was entitled, "Mental Health and the Developing Brain in the Second Decade of Life: Research Challenges and Opportunities" It highlighted the importance of viewing adolescence as a unique period of brain development, one in which Structural changes in the brain are profound, and underlie many psychological changes.
