THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S ANNUAL REPORT ON ACCESS TO CERTAIN BUSINESS RECORDS FOR FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE PURPOSES UNDER THE FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE SURVEILLANCE ACT

### APRIL 2005

This report is submitted pursuant to the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (the "Act"), 50 U.S.C. §§ 1861-1862, as amended, and covers all applications for access to certain business records (including the production of tangible things) for foreign intelligence purposes under the Act during the calendar year 2005. (U)

The Government filed 155 applications with the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court (FISC) seeking authorization for access to certain business records (including the production of tangible things) for foreign intelligence purposes during this period. Of these 155 applications, 141 were combined pen register and/or trap and trace devices/business records applications. (b)(1)

The Court made substantive modifications to the Government's proposed orders in two applications submitted to the Court. The Court did not deny, in whole or in part, any application submitted by the Government during calendar year 2005. (S)
