22	The State of Arizona ex rel. Thomas C. Horne, Attorney General ("State"), and		
23	Western Union Financial Services, Inc. ("Western Union"), respectfully move the		
24	Court to enter an order in the form of the attached proposed order extending the time		
25	for Western Union to provide transaction data to the State under the terms of the		
26	Settlement Agreement between them dated February 11, 2010, and the Amendment to		
27	the Settlement Agreement dated January 31, 2014.		
28			

The Amendment to the Settlement Agreement requires Western Union to provide certain transaction data to the State and other Participating States for five years after the date of the Amendment. Amendment ¶ 9 (Agreement ¶ 17.1.6). The Amendment also requires Western Union to fund the Transaction Record Analysis Center ("TRAC") for five years with payments of \$150,000.00 per month.

Amendment ¶ 12.7. In addition, the Amendment provides that if the expenses of TRAC in any year are below the amount paid by Western Union to fund TRAC, the difference will be credited to Western Union's obligation to fund TRAC for the following year. Amendment ¶ 12.9.

Pursuant to the terms of the Amendment, Western Union did not begin providing the data required by the Amendment for several months after the Amendment was approved by the Court because the State and Western Union agreed to extend the time for the Participating States to execute separate agreements with Western Union regarding the provision of data. As a result, Western Union's payments to fund TRAC accumulated, which was not anticipated by the parties when they executed the Amendment. Therefore, the State and Western Union have agreed to extend the time for Western Union to provide data to the State and the Participating States for several months through June 30, 2019, and to allow any surplus of funds from payments in 2014 to carry over to fund TRAC during the extended time for data production. The modifications to the Settlement Agreement and Amendment required to implement this agreement are reflected in the attached proposed order.
