	The State of Arizona ex rel. Mark I	Brnovich, Attorney General ("State"), and
27	Western Union Financial Services, Inc. ("Western Union"), respectfully move the Court	
28		

to enter an Order of Dismissal With Prejudice to conclude this case. A proposed Order of Dismissal With Prejudice, approved as to form by the parties through their signatures below, is being lodged along with the filing of this joint motion.

On February 24, 2010, the Court approved the Settlement Agreement between the State and Western Union and, on January 31, 2014, the Court approved the parties' Amendment to Settlement Agreement which was later modified by various orders including, but not limited to, an Order Granting Stipulation to Extend Time for Production of Data filed October 17, 2014. A Final Order concluding the matter between the parties was entered on June 9, 2017, but the Court retained jurisdiction for the limited purpose of remaining available to assist with the continuing obligations under paragraphs 12.7 and 17.1.6 of the Settlement Agreement, as amended, and the Court's Order dated January 31, 2014. Those limited continuing obligations conclude on June 30, 2019.

The parties represent that each has complied with its obligations under the instruments noted in the preceding paragraph and that Western Union has adhered to its obligations to provide data to the State. The parties agree that all data provided to the State through June 30, 2019, shall remain subject to the terms and conditions of the Amendment to the Settlement Agreement and the Court's Order dated January 31, 2014, until the data is destroyed.

No further matters remain pending and an Order of Dismissal concluding the civil cause number may be entered.

This Court has commented previously on the genesis of this case; the parties' agreement that, instead of engaging in a complex court litigation, they would attempt to create a best practices for an anti-money laundering program; and on the parties' entry of a Settlement Agreement, as amended, under which the parties worked cooperatively and collaboratively and committed vast human and financial resources in order to achieve that purpose. The Court has commended the parties for those efforts and stated that the commitment and dedication of the Arizona Attorney General's Office and Western

Union have resulted in a much broader and longer lasting benefit to the people of Arizona and the United States than would have been accomplished by any litigation. As a result, this case was designated as historically significant and reposited in the Arizona State Library Archives and Public Records.

The parties would be remiss in moving for the entry of a concluding order without offering their respect, appreciation, and gratitude for the judicial oversight and stewardship provided in this action by the Hon. Warren J. Granville. Without his considerable contributions to this action, the Settlement Agreement might not have been reached, the results of the Settlement Agreement and Amendment would not have been achieved, and the case's historical significance and, most importantly, its benefit to the people of this state and country certainly could not have been realized.
