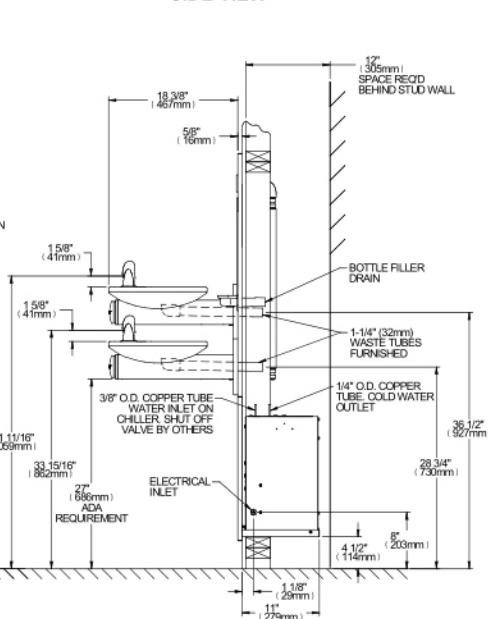
WALL LAYOUT



FRONT VIEW

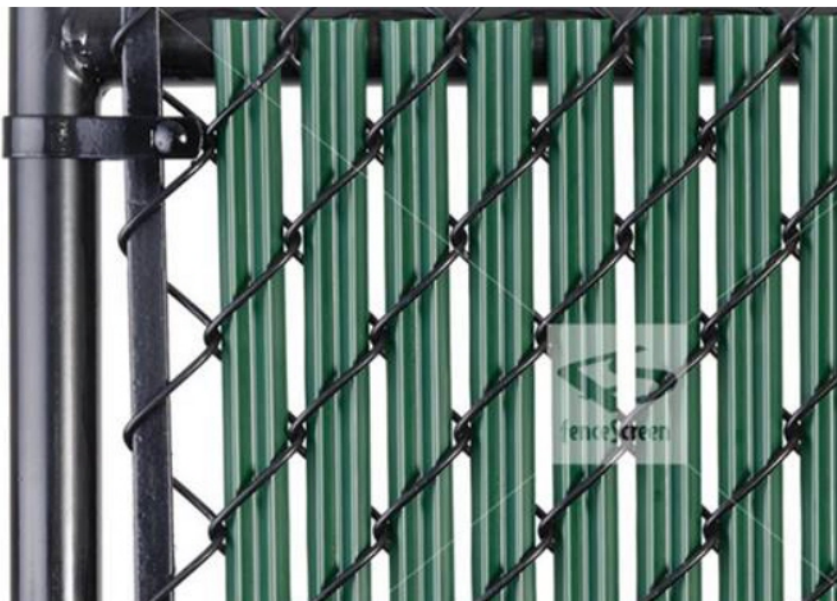
