S1 MESSAGES FOR HSAC – CLOSED SESSION

February 3, 2010

- Very glad that we're having these important discussions about steps we can work together on to counter violent extremism.
- As you know, several incidents over the past year have brought heightened attention to domestic violent extremism.
- And, of course, the failed attempt to attack Flight 253 on December 25th was a powerful illustration that terrorists will go to great lengths to defeat the security measures we have put in place since 9/11.
- It is critical that we work together at all levels — federal, state and local governments, our international partners, faith and community organizations, and the American public — to counter these threats.
- I'm proud of the fact that DHS has built strong relationships with many faith and community groups across the country. And we're now discussing ways to strengthen the relationships we already have, and learn from successes we've had.
- In times of crisis, faith leaders and other grassroots organizations often play a critical role in getting accurate information out to their communities. So I look forward to hearing more about the results of your discussions today.
