

**Synopsis:** (U) Town Hall meeting with the Somali Community at ACEDONE, Roxbury, MA

**Details:**

On November 7, 2014, COS [redacted] SAC Lisi, and ASAC [redacted] participated and sat on a panel at a Somali Community Town Hall Meeting at ACEDONE, Roxbury, MA. SAC Lisi discussed the responsibilities of the FBI and what the FBI investigates. He explained how the community has rights and that the FBI does not have Agents in mosques trying to get information. Questions and concerns included problems with the youth being recruited for ISIS and how to get them to stay out of trouble if they can't obtain jobs, etc. A Youth Academy was discussed which would be taking place in the next couple of weeks.
