Details: On June 14, 2014, FBI Houston participated in a DHS "Countering Violent Extremism" community exercise hosted by the Harris County Sheriff's office. The event brought together approximately 60 law enforcement officers and Muslim community leaders for a four hour exercise which contained a radicalization scenario. FBI Assistant Special Agent in b6 -2 Charge FBI Supervisory Special Agent b7C -2 FBI Special Agent and FBI Public Affairs participated in the event. Facilitators led Specialist the group into discussions about "red flag" behaviors, the appropriate role of the family versus the role of law enforcement in dealing with disaffected youths, the point at which law enforcement involvement is appropriate, the need to avoid "profiling" of disaffected Muslim youth as "terrorists", and other important topics were discussed. b6 -2 On June 25, 2014, Special Agent attended the b7C -2 quarterly meeting of the Islamic Society of Greater Houston (ISGH) board of directors. The invitation was a result of discussions that took place at the Countering Violent Extremism workshop of June 14.
