

No entry may be made into eGuardian based solely on:

The ethnicity, race or religion of an individual

The exercise of rights, that are guaranteed by the First Amendment

THEL

The lawful exercise of any other right secured by the Constitution or the laws of the United States.

The following categories of information <u>will not</u> be permitted to be entered into eGuardian:

- Classified information
- Information that divulges sensitive methods and techniques

DRELL

- □ FISA- derived information
- Grand jury information
- Federal taxpayer information
- Sealed indictments
- Sealed court proceedings
- Confidential human source and witness information
- Title III subject and intercept information
