As far as I know, the E-Guardian controversy is over the claim by several briefers that MPD's AMS will directly feed E-Guardian. No one at MPD has been given technical information on how to do this, or even any actual tasking to do so. I personally made it clear to the MPD Fusion Center officials that the plan we were aware of was for the Shared Space to feed E-Guardian, i.e. it would happen but not be built by MPD.

The conference went great. We ended up not actually demoing, but the Chief had seen it live the day before, and gave a good description of how it all works.
