To All:

We are pleased to note that the Deputy Attorney General has approved the Department of Justice Privacy, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties Protection Policy for the Information Sharing Environment. A copy of the DAG's Memorandum and the Policy are attached for your reference. This memorandum specifically states that it applies immediately to component NSI participants. Thus, any real or perceived concerns about eGuardian's privacy status can be relaxed. In addition, we want to assure you that all of the data currently residing in eGuardian has been thoroughly scrubbed; we are confident that these SARs meet all civil liberty protection requirements.

The approval of this policy comes at a critical time given the terrorist threat our country is presently facing in the wake of the Fort Hood and Christmas Day Flight 253 attacks. We encourage you to immediately send us any suspicious activity reports you have regarding terrorism-related activity. Please allow me to extend our sincere appreciation to everyone who worked tirelessly to make this important policy a reality.
