On behalf of Thomas O'Reilly, the NSI Director, and Roger Morrison, FBI's eGuardian, the NSI is happy to announce the completion of the electronic push function for SARs from your shared space server to your local Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF) through eGuardian. This process has been tested and completed. The work for this project was made possible through a strong cooperative effort of all the fusion centers who provided test data, the eGuardian technical staff, and the NSI technical staff.

This completes the two phased approach undertaken within the NSI to not only make eGuardian information available in the NSI federated search, but also to provide the current participating fusion centers a methodology to move SARs from your legacy systems (or SVT) both to the shared space server and to the JTTF through eGuardian.
