With this in mind, all SARs in eGuardian are available in the NSI Federated Search, as well as information submitted by Fusion Centers and DHS. The FBI has access to all SARs in the NSI Federated Search. There are currently more than 15,000 SAR available from all sources, however this is a dynamic system with information constantly being added and purged.
