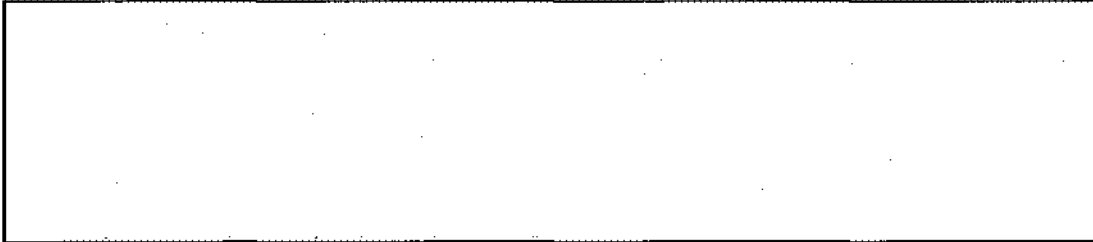

Since February 2009, [redacted] has initiated four investigations targeting bulletproof hosts. The main objective of this assessment is to identify all bulletproof hosts in the Silicon Valley region and information about the company, to include but not limited to the owners, incorporation, location of servers, and upstream providers. Additionally, intelligence on the types of activities being provided by the bulletproof hosts will be identified to assess the operational effects of the threats. It is anticipated that targets for investigation will be identified through this process.
