On 11/08/2001, [redacted] at the Islamic Society of the East Bay (ISEB) was contacted at the ISEB, 33330 Peace Terrace, Fremont, California, by Special Agent (SA) [redacted] McCranie and by Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms SA [redacted]. [redacted] was advised of the identity of the interviewing agents, and that the purpose of the interview was to ascertain if anyone associated with the ISEB had recently been the victim of a hate crime. He responded that, to his knowledge, neither he nor anyone associated with the ISEB has been the victim of a recent hate crime. He was provided with the name and telephone number of the San Francisco Division's Hate Crime Coordinator, SA [redacted] in the event that he became aware of the commission of a hate crime in the future. He was also provided with English and Arabic versions of the FBI "Victim/Witness" brochure.
