Synopsis: EC to document Community Outreach efforts.

Details: On April 13, 2010, SAC Parenti participated in a "Town Hall" style meeting at the Islamic Center of the San Joaquin Valley in Bakersfield, California. The meeting was open to all members of the area's Muslim Community. Also participating were U.S. Attorney Benjamin Wagner and SSRA [redacted] Bakersfield RA. There were approximately 60 people in attendance, including Muslim Community leadership. The discussions centered on various concerns expressed by the Muslim Community; FBI Outreach Programs; the FBI's role in federal criminal Civil Rights investigations; and substantial discussion of FBI recruiting efforts in the Muslim Community. Several positive comments were made by the attendees during the meeting concerning the excellent outreach efforts of the Bakersfield RA to the Muslim Community, and the professionalism of SSRA [redacted] and the staff in the RA.
