For your review, enclosed is the Sacramento Division's Community Outreach Program Semiannual Report for July 1, 2006-December 31, 2006. As the Division's part-time Community Outreach Coordinator, during the referenced period, I oversaw the following Community Outreach Program activities: Citizens' Academy (CA); Minority Liaison Outreach; Youth Programs; Sport/Drug Awareness Initiatives; and Law Enforcement Partnerships. In addition, I have provided program support to the recruiting program.


Included in this semiannual report is statistical information required during inspection periods, along with budget information. For example, between July 1, 2006-December 31, 2006, the field office held, sponsored, and/or actively participated in several liaison/outreach activities. Additionally, 20 Citizens' Academy participants graduated from the program. Moreover, for this reporting period, 30% of our CA graduates are Asian, 10% African American, 15% Hispanic and 10% members of InfraGard.

Along with providing assistance and useful information to the communities we serve, our outreach efforts also resulted in significant program accomplishments. For instance, during this period, outreach to the minority communities greatly increased.

Traditionally, the Community Outreach Program has been an established network of resources. However, as outlined in the semiannual report, the program has also facilitated information sharing and collaborative operations between the community and the FBI's investigative programs. Moreover, Sacramento Division's Community Outreach Program supports the FBI's mission and investigative priorities.
