Synopsis: To report on investigation of [redacted]

Details: On 08/13/2003, the FBI, San Francisco Division, San Jose Resident Agency received a telephone call from San Jose Police Department (SJPD) [redacted] LNU, telephone number [redacted] who provided information that a SJPD patrol had identified a suspicious vehicle parked in the vicinity of the Santa Clara County Government Building, the San Jose Police Station, and the San Jose Hall of Justice. The vehicle had Virginia license plates, had not been moved in several days, and had a package in plain-view from the window with [redacted] [redacted] In conjunction with the proximity to public government buildings, the out-of-state status of the vehicle, and the identification of the [redacted] SJPD notified the FBI of a possible [redacted] situation.

The check of [redacted] records revealed that the vehicle, [redacted] was registered to [redacted] Arlington, Virginia. A search [redacted] revealed that [redacted] was [redacted] years of age, DOB: [redacted] [redacted] issued in Florida on in 1995) [redacted] apartment manager, told Arlington P.D. that she believed that [redacted] had departed the United States and returned to his native country [redacted]

On 08/11/2003, [redacted] was arrested by SJPD.
[redacted] gave [redacted] CA as his current
address. [redacted] had been previously arrested on 07/05/2003,

conducted with the Santa Clara County Sheriff's office, which
verified that [redacted] had been remained into custody by a
judge during a court appearance on 08/11/2003 [Note: this is the

Two (2) SJPD explosive detection dogs were sent around
the vehicle and did not 'hit' on the presence of explosives. The
SJPD directed that the vehicle be towed and inventoried as
abandoned. The vehicle was moved to a SJPD lot, [redacted]
[redacted] CA, where an inventory of the vehicle was
conducted. Special Agent [redacted] was present during this
inventory and took video of some of the items observed during the
inventory. A copy of this original video cassette will be
maintained in the 1-A section of the [redacted] file.

A check was conducted of the FBI ACS database system. There was one (1) instance of the presence of the name [redacted] which was an FD-71 reported on 06/24/2003 [redacted] serial 1688); that reported [redacted] as a possible person of interest, by SJPD, due to his criminal contact with [redacted]. A telephone number for [redacted] in Arlington, VA was listed as [redacted]. A further search of ACS was conducted for all names and addresses associated to this investigation or discovered during the inventory of the vehicle. There were several positive 'hits' on a few telephone numbers found in the vehicle during the inventory. The numbers came back to the [redacted].

This report was written to memorialize and summarize the investigation that occurred on 08/13/2003, that was undertaken in an effort to determine the possible threat of the vehicle with Virginia license plates which was found unattended, in the vicinity of several local government buildings. An attempt will be made to contact and interview [redacted] in the [redacted] County jail in the near future. There are no other investigative efforts that are deemed necessary at this time to further pursue this matter.
