Synopsis: The Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) outreach to the local mosques in the Sacramento area.

Details: On 07/11/2008, Special Agents [Redacted] met with Imam [Redacted] at Masjid Ibrahim located at Rio Linda Boulevard, Sacramento, CA 95838.

Information was shared regarding the FBI's efforts on counterterrorism and civil rights. Ideas were exchanged about the FBI's image within the Muslim community, as well as the Muslim community's image within the community at large.

Imam [Redacted] talked about Muslim integration in U.S. society. Imam [Redacted] spoke of the growing influence of American Muslim communities and clarified some widely accepted myths about Muslims.
