Synopsis: To document meeting with writer and SA [redacted] with Ethiopian community leader.

Details: On 12/22/2008, SA [redacted] and writer met with [redacted] Ethiopian Community & Cultural Center, 353 Grand Avenue #1B, Oakland, CA 94610, telephone 510-268-4770, to discuss the San Francisco Division's community outreach initiatives such as the Citizens' Academy, Adopt-A-School/Mentoring programs, along with National ID Program which provides fingerprint kits for children. [redacted] expressed interest in both the mentoring programs and ID kits and advised writer that she would talk with members of the Ethiopian community about both programs. Writer also provided [redacted] with information on internship programs and employment opportunities with the FBI. [redacted] advised that the current economic climate has hit the Ethiopian community particularly hard and employment opportunities within the professional support and linguist program would be of significant interest within the community.

[redacted] will arrange a follow up meeting for writer and SA [redacted] with the community center executive board members to discuss the above initiatives. Writer and SA [redacted] were also invited to participate in the next Ethiopian Day Festival held in September at Lake Merritt in Oakland. The festival attracts approximately 2,000 residents and citizens of Ethiopian origin each year. [redacted] thought it would be a good opportunity for the
