As discussed with each of you, the current CVE portal defines violent extremism as follows: "encouraging, condoning, justifying, or supporting the commission of a violent or criminal act to achieve political, ideological, religious, social, or	

economic goals." This was taken directly from the FBI's lexicon guide, but regrettably that guide contains an error. The phrase "or criminal" from the above definition permits this definition to sweep so broadly as to include a person committing voter fraud in furtherance of his political ideology. Surely, that would not constitute "violent extremism." As such, I believe this needs to be revised. At the same time, it's my understanding there is a new Tiger Team definition. I'm looping both of you up here to encourage a discussion among you as to which is the better term to use. Also copying as well.
