1. PURPOSE

Original purpose of the Award:

 The Recipient shall produce two short animated video clips plays on the subject of countering violent extremism.

The objectives of this project are to: reach mass audiences using digital media and live action stage performances to disseminate mission critical messages to counter extremist ideologies.

The recipient agrees to:

- Produce two 60-90 second animated video clips that will communicate messages to:
 - Engage youth in productive activities and avoid extremist thinking
 - Provide a thorough understanding of Islam as a tolerant and peaceful religion.
 - Promote national unity, social cohesiveness
 - Stimulate dialogue to encourage conflict resolution and de-escalate violence levels in Jordanian universities, in part due to more extreme thought on campuses.
