

Synopsis: (U//FOUO) OPE announces the scheduling of a community focus group to review CVE products to be considered by field offices when addressing counterterrorism (CT) related violent extremism in the community. The focus group will be July 31, 2015 at FBIHQ, Washington, D.C.

Countering Violent Extremism Section (CVE) and Office of Public Affairs (OPA) is in the process of finalizing a number of options for a field office to consider when addressing CT related violent extremism in the community:

- MOU for an "Off-Ramp". Completed and OGC approved.
- CVE Awareness Film. January 2016.
- Schools – Public Affairs Guidance. September 2015.
- Juvenile Indicators (NCTC/FBI collaboration). September 2015.
- FBI.gov CVE Portal with OPA (High School). September 2015

The above efforts will engage members of the community. During this focus group they will review the Portal with OPA and the MOU with OPE and provide input. Please nominate members of your community who could provide constructive feedback on this endeavor. Please provide their full name, telephone number, name of organization, and email address. Once all nominations are received, a final selection will be made. OPE will send the formal invitation to the attendees via email.

The focus group is Friday, July 31, 2015, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., at FBIHQ, 935 Pennsylvania Ave. N.W., Washington, D.C. Attendees will be greeted in the Visitor's Center and escorted to the meeting room. Attendees requiring extended travel will arrive in Washington, D.C. on July 30, 2015.
