## Purpose of SPOT

 Identify high-risk individuals who may pose a threat to transportation security

2

 Screen individuals and their accessible property using behavior and appearance detection techniques

3

 Detect anomalous behavior using objective measures

An additional layer of security



A focus on intent, not solely on the means



## SPOT Overview: Scoring Process

## A standardized scoring process is:

- An objective measure of risk that is threshold driven
- Based on deviations from an established environmental baseline using standard indicators
- Meant to increase reliability between BDOs and to avoid personal biases and stereotypes




