Hi, for those of you who I haven't met, I'm the Secretary's Counselor for Human Services and have been the department's POC for the NSC-led effort around "countering violent extremism." In recent years, the NSC, DHS, and DOJ have become increasingly interested in applying what they see as public health approaches to the problem. One example of this is work that Boston has done, which is outlined in the attached framework. Separately, DHS has the attached draft from the National Academy for a conference/workshop, which is outlined in italics below.

The newly-formed Countering Violent Extremism interagency task force is interested if "any or all of the HHS [key] components...could come in and talk about their existing programs and potential opportunities for collaboration." But before we do that, I think we should have an HHS discussion of the potential here, focused on what people think of the Boston framework. I will see about putting something on the calendar – please let me know if there are others who should be included.

In the meantime, we also have an ask for feedback on the NAS proposal by May 11th. So if you could provide me any thoughts you have by COB May 9th, that would be helpful:

For awareness, I've had discussions with George Selim periodically over the last two or so years. Traditionally, our "countering violent extremism" role has focused on the refugee resettlement work at

ACF (which is why I've been involved) but more recently the NSC has also become interested in the behavioral health work of SAMHSA and the anti-violence funding from CDC. Our experts have argued that making direct explicit links between their social service work and the CVE work is likely to be counter-productive. They fear that it would be seen as "we're only helping you because we're scared you're going to be violent" in the impacted communities, rather than "we're helping you because we're welcoming you to America." But if there are cities like Boston or Minneapolis that want to use some of our money to address needs in communities at risk for CVE, that's fine. We just think a "top-down" push to do so would be unwise. I've told George this and even facilitated a conversation for him with some of our experts at the beginning of the year.

Hi, for those of you who I haven't met, I'm the Secretary's Counselor for Human Services and have been the department's POC for the NSC-led effort around "countering violent extremism." In recent years, the NSC, DHS, and DOJ have become increasingly interested in applying what they see as public health approaches to the problem. One example of this is work that Boston has done, which is outlined in the attached framework. Separately, DHS has the attached draft from the National Academy for a conference/workshop, which is outlined in italics below.

The newly-formed Countering Violent Extremism interagency task force is interested if "any or all of the HHS [key] components...could come in and talk about their existing programs and potential opportunities for collaboration." But before we do that, I think we should have an HHS discussion of the potential here, focused on what people think of the Boston framework. I will see about putting something on the calendar – please let me know if there are others who should be included.

In the meantime, we also have an ask for feedback on the NAS proposal by May 11th. So if you could provide me any thoughts you have by COB May 9th, that would be helpful:

At this point, I'm not clear which experts would meet their needs. Sometimes he talked about intergenerational family conflict, sometimes it was patient referrals to law enforcement by mental health centers, and then sometimes it was prevention and health promotion.

If the sites want to focus on people with serious mental illness, there is one researcher who is really a leader in the area of violence. His name is Jeff Swanson from Duke. I don't think has done work in the area of violent extremism, per se, but to the degree there is a subset of people w unmanaged mental illness with a higher probability of committing a violent act, Jeff is the guy.
