

American society. The "countering violent extremism" aspect to date has been "ACF should do its job well" so that people don't become alienated and angry, not any specific anti-terrorism work.

The NSS has been thinking more broadly of late and reached out to Bill at the beginning of the year to get this on the radar of our leadership. They have noticed that SAMHSA has been doing more behavioral health work with "Now is the Time" and CDC has some violence prevention work. So they're trying to figure out if there is a way those efforts could feed into their anti-terrorism work. More specifically, they seem to be trying to come up with some demo funding in a couple of cities – say Boston and Detroit – that would package together social service spending that would reach teens and 20-somethings from communities of concern, such as those who might be drawn to the war in Syria. But they know little about our programs and don't seem to be talking to their colleagues who do.

So I think I need to get a few people together to talk over this ask. Suggestions? If, as I suspect is the case, this doesn't make sense to our experts, I may need to chat with Bill before we tell them this. He hasn't pushed me to take it to this degree but he'll probably need an update in case people don't like our answer. Or maybe Pam would love to get SAMHSA working on this....

I must admit, I have no recollection of meeting with the U.S. Attorney in Boston regarding the topic of countering violent extremism. The only situation that comes to mind, is that I had an extreme message left on our Boston voice mail system, Summer of 2015. It was quite disturbing and it appeared to be a domestic, extremism type message. I immediately reported to our CO, The GSA SIP Liaison Official (Boston) and the Federal Protection Service Mega Center. Two reports filed – one for NYC and one for Boston as we ended up having a voice mail messages in both offices.

Additionally, I sit in on the Region I, Regional Director's bi-weekly meeting and participate in a Prevention Collaborative in Boston, but I do not recall meeting with anyone or speaking with anyone from the U.S. Attorney's Office on this topic.

As some of you know, the NSC has been interested in social service or public health work that could help communities of concern in their efforts to "counter violent extremism," such as the Boston Marathon bombing. I've been our contact on the White House's "countering violent extremism" strategy, which is mostly an effort to head off Americans (or people living here) from becoming terrorists, a la the Boston bombing or Somali-American kids in Minnesota going Jihadi. That's because our main role has been ACF's refugee programs, which are intended to help get families on their feet economically and integrated into American society. The "countering violent extremism" aspect to date has been "ACF should do its job well" so that people don't become alienated and angry, not any specific anti-terrorism work.

The NSS has been thinking more broadly of late and reached out to Bill at the beginning of the year to get this on the radar of our leadership. They have noticed that SAMHSA has been doing more behavioral health work with "Now is the Time" and CDC has some violence prevention work. So they're trying to figure out if there is a way those efforts could feed into their anti-terrorism work. More specifically, they seem to be trying to come up with some demo funding in a couple of cities – say Boston and Detroit – that would package together social service spending that would reach teens and 20-somethings from communities of concern, such as those who might be drawn to the war in Syria. But they know little about our programs and don't seem to be talking to their colleagues who do.

So I think I need to get a few people together to talk over this ask. Suggestions? If, as I suspect is the case, this doesn't make sense to our experts, I may need to chat with Bill before we tell them this. He hasn't pushed me to take it to this degree but he'll probably need an update in case people don't like our answer. Or maybe Pam would love to get SAMHSA working on this....

We have a supporting role to law enforcement types and much of the interagency discussion has been taken up by DHS and DOJ arguing over who should lead and how to balance their respective interests with little attention to the support we may be called upon to provide, such as helping make sure relevant community leaders can local mental health services for troubled young people or connecting law enforcement with our refugee resettlement partners if needed.

It's gotten to the point of drafting a charter, a version of which is attached. Would OGC want to review this?

I'm the departmental point person for the NSC-led "Countering Violent Extremism" initiative, in part because it has historically focused (for HHS) on the refugee communities ACF serves. DOJ reached out to me about efforts in Massachusetts that have evolved in the years since the marathon bombings to develop a "public health" approach to preventing people from turning to violent ideologies, such as those of ISIS. They said the US Attorney in Boston has talked to a number of our regional staff, including Betsy Rosenfeld, about the kind of subject matter expertise HHS can provide. As some of you know, the NSC has been interested in social service or public health work that could help communities of concern in their efforts to "counter violent extremism," such as the Boston Marathon bombing. As we have explained to them in the past, our departmental position has been that it is not helpful to explicitly label our various efforts to assist refugees or provide mental health resources or anti-violence funding as being about "violent extremism." That said, if a community uses some of our funding in a fashion that might help with populations of concern, that's up to them if they win the grant competition (or whatever).

The NSC had three initial cities they were working with – LA, Minneapolis, and Boston. We previously provided them with a description of funding that might be available in those communities, such as grants they had received from CDC and SAMHSA. They’d now like something similar pulled together for a set of potential second round communities. The list is below. Could you compile short descriptions of any current funding that goes directly to the local level in these areas from your array of grants? It would be helpful to have something next week, if that’s not too much to ask.

Hi Doug, I thought George was going to poll some of the sites to identify specific topics in which they might be interested so we'd have a better idea of how to be helpful. At this point, I'm not clear which experts would meet their needs.

Sometimes he talked about intergenerational family conflict, sometimes it was patient referrals to law enforcement by mental health centers, and then sometimes it was prevention and health promotion.

If the sites want to focus on people with serious mental illness, there is one researcher who is really a leader in the area of violence. His name is Jeff Swanson from Duke. I don't think has done work in the area of violent extremism, per se, but to the degree there is a subset of people w unmanaged mental illness with a higher probability of committing a violent act, Jeff is the guy.

Doug - Yes, our preference is to work with local communities outside the “countering Violent Extremism” narrative. While ORR’s direct engagement and services may be restricted to those who have been in the country for less than five years, ORR’s outreach and collaboration with refugee populations extend far past their initial resettlement period, as well as post-naturalization, as refugees transition from being newly-arrived to established, and ultimately full participants in American communities. One of the most concrete ways in which ORR engages with refugee communities is through its Ethnic Community Self Help Program. The objective of the program is to support ethnic community-based organizations (ECBOs) in providing refugee populations with critical services to assist them in becoming integrated members of American society.

Currently, ECBOs are directly funded under the program to provide culturally and linguistically appropriate services to refugees of diverse ethnic and national origins. (Indirectly, ORR funds countless other ECBOs through state subcontracts and similar mechanisms.) Project activities typically include organizational capacity development; outreach to mainstream communities; cultural orientation and life skills education; financial literacy training; English as a Second Language (ESL) training; youth-targeted programs; referrals to care providers, and direct refugee service provision.
