

# WORDE Publishes Research in the Journal, Behavioral Science & Policy



Research into the psychology of terrorism suggests that a person's cultural identity plays a key role in radicalization, so WORDE teamed up with researchers Dr. Sarah Lyons, Dr. Michelle Gelfand, and Marieke van Egmond for a study to understand how immigrant acculturation challenges in the US may be linked to radicalization. We found that immigrants who identify with neither their heritage culture nor the culture they are living in feel marginalized and insignificant. Experiences of discrimination make the situation worse and could lead to greater support for radical, fundamental groups.


