Program Narrative

<u>Disparate Agreement:</u> Ouachita Parish is certified disparate with the City of Monroe. The total award amount FY2008 disclosed by the United States Department of Justice is \$24,329. As in the past the City of Monroe and Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office have agreed to divide the funds equally; the City of Monroe is to receive \$12,164.50 and the Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office is to receive \$12,164.50. It is agreed that the Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office will file the appropriate grant proposal for both entities.

Purpose Area: Law Enforcement Technology Improvement The Ouachita Parish Criminal Justice Community is seeking a comprehensive solution for the implementation of a highly efficient and secure network for purposes of enabling real time information sharing and data integration among the law enforcement agencies, district attorney's office, clerk of court and judicial court system. The intent of the network is to enable real time information sharing among the member agencies and to allow for the automation of important E-Justice systems. The Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office is requesting funding for surveillance equipment to assist in the detection and apprehension of criminal terrorists in our community. The data we will install will enhance existing data system by adding the ability to collect visual evidence at an incident and deliver that evidence to our server immediately after the incident is concluded. This classification (or priority level) is passed to the management solution in the agency where definable operational rules allow for the automated processing and categorization of specific classes of incidents. The Monroe Police Department will upgrade their wireless communication and information technology through software and hardware.

2008 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this 8th day of July, 2008, by and between OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE, acting as Louisiana Law dictates, it's own governing entity and the CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT, acting by and through its governing body, Monroe City Council, hereinafter referred to as the City of Monroe, both within the parish of Ouachita, State of Louisiana, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interest of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

WHEREAS, OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE agrees to provide the CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT from the JAG award for their law enforcement equipment needs; and

WHEREAS, OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE and CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT believe it to be their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

Section 1.

OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE agrees to pay the CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT a total of \$ 12,164.50 of JAG funds.

Section 2.

CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT agrees to use \$12,164.50 to purchase necessary equipment to be used for law enforcement activity until September 30, 2011.

Section 3.

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do no intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not signatory hereto.
