### Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Ouachita Parish Technology Improvement Program

#### Program Narrative

**Disparate Agreement:** Ouachita Parish is certified disparate with the City of Monroe. The total award amount FY2008 disclosed by the United States Department of Justice is \$24,329. As in the past the City of Monroe and Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office have agreed to divide the funds equally; the City of Monroe is to receive \$12,164.50 and the Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office is to receive \$12,164.50. It is agreed that the Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office will file the appropriate grant proposal for both entities.

**Purpose Area: Law Enforcement Technology Improvement** The Ouachita Parish Criminal Justice Community is seeking a comprehensive solution for the implementation of a highly efficient and secure network for purposes of enabling real time information sharing and data integration among the law enforcement agencies, district attorney's office, clerk of court and judicial court system. The intent of the network is to enable real time information sharing among the member agencies and to allow for the automation of important E-Justice systems. The Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office is requesting funding for surveillance equipment to assist in the detection and apprehension of criminal terrorists in our community. The data we will install will enhance existing data system by adding the ability to collect visual evidence at an incident and deliver that evidence to our server immediately after the incident is concluded. This classification (or priority level) is passed to the management solution in the agency where definable operational rules allow for the automated processing and categorization of specific classes of incidents. The Monroe Police Department will upgrade their wireless communication and information technology through software and hardware.

#### Budget Narrative

#### Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Ouachita Parish Technology Improvement Program

##### Review Narrative

**Monroe Police Department Proposal Review:** A public hearing will be held in the Council Chamber at Monroe City Hall relative to the Justice Assistance Grant for FY 2008 for the Ouachita Parish Criminal Justice Community in particular the Monroe City Police Department. At this time, the Justice Assistance Grant Proposal was available for review by the Monroe City Council for discussion at this public meeting. There was no one present who wished to speak in opposition of the grant proposal. Chief of Police Ron Schleuter spoke in favor of the grant and its proposed purchases. There were approximately 75 citizens present at the council meeting. Proof of agenda and publication of the proposed meeting, appearing in the local daily newspaper will be on file.

The Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office Administration received a copy of the Justice Assistance Grant Proposal July 8, 2008 for review. On July 8 – August 8, 2008 the Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office, being its own public entity, will make the Justice Assistance Grant Proposal available to the public for discussion and review from 8:30 am – 4:30 pm at two locations; 400 St. John Street, Monroe, Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office Administration and 420 Wheelis Street Room 11, West Monroe, Grant Manager's Office. This action will be advertised in the News Star, a local daily paper, twice during this time and public notice was posted in prominent places on parish government buildings from July 8, 2007 until August 8, 2008. If no one presents opposition to the application or proposed expenditures, we will proceed with purchase of said equipment. Proof of legal advertisement and other postings will be on file.

2008 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this 8<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2008, by and between OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE, acting as Louisiana Law dictates, its own governing entity and the CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT, acting by and through its governing body, Monroe City Council, hereinafter referred to as the City of Monroe, both within the parish of Ouachita, State of Louisiana, witnesseth:

**WHEREAS**, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interest of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE agrees to provide the CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT from the JAG award for their law enforcement equipment needs; and

**WHEREAS**, OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE and CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT believe it to be their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

Section 1.

OUACHITA PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE agrees to pay the CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT a total of \$ 12,164.50 of JAG funds.

Section 2.

CITY OF MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT agrees to use \$12,164.50 to purchase necessary equipment to be used for law enforcement activity until September 30, 2011.
