CVE Working Group Meeting 3/22 at 3:00 p.m. Summary of Conclusions

Observations:

- Discussed Embassy CVE White Paper and way forward; agreed for need to research and draft Embassy CVE strategy, looking at Sahel, Saudi, Egypt and other missions.
- Read-out of PAS session for Government of Jordan policy and communications officials with CSCC.
- · Read-out of PAS discussions with Min. Majali concerning Media Response Unit.
- Discussed upcoming Jordan-hosted meeting of Coalition Small Group Summit, April 8 in Amman.
 - o POL (Rohit) has overall lead, Catherine Miller-Little assisting. Assigned Joe Giordono-Scholz as PAS main contact.
 - Discussed which Working Groups would make most sense for Jordan to join/lead.
- Updated on status of CMSE/USAID proposal for CVE data study.
 - o DATT/MAP has cleared, being finalized for Front Office clearance.
 - o Briefed on possible cooperation and coordination with EU, which is also commissioning a longer-term study.
 - Recommending moving ahead with MIL Team funding mechanism and implementer, which has done similar work recently in Jordan.
- LEGATT noted that Foreign Exchanges Unit at FBI undergoing some administrative changes, so has cancelled some trainings in region. Pushing FBI to set dates for engagement in Jordan.
- PAS updated on Tech Camp to take place 21-22 April in Amman and on Single Country Program sending key GOJ messaging offials on interagency working tour, approximately 27 May – 10 June. Finalizing selection of participants for the SCP.

Action Items:

- PAS (Joe) to start drafting Embassy Amman CVE strategy, with input from Working Group members.
- CMSE and USAID to clear CVE data study proposal with rest of CVE Group and Front Office.
- MAP to set up tour of MRU once it's established and running.
- LEGATT to follow-up on MOI Majali and FBI training.
- PAS to disseminate Tech Camps information as confirmed.
