## DHS Security Warning to Aviation Community

- The employees of TSA make up the frontlines of defense for the Department of Homeland Security and our mission is vital to protecting the American people from a constant and evolving threat
- Terrorist groups continue to target aviation using evolving techniques.
- On Wednesday, February 19, DHS issued a warning about new threats to commercial airline flights, based on credible intelligence.
- The warning emphasizes that flights originating from international destinations traveling to the United States
  could carry passengers attempting to hide explosives in their shoes
- According to the warning, at this time there is no specific plot, no particular airline targeted, and no particular country is known to be the source of the threat
- All employees are urged to remain vigitant and review existing security protocols intended to counter harmful concealments
- We will provide updates as information becomes available on this situation
