Introduction from Senior Coordinator on Boko Haram

- Second P3 Capitals Senior working level dialogue was held on Friday 23 October, and was a productive discussion
 - Various high level visits:
 - Buhari and Deby were in Paris
 - Of note, Buhari mentioned potential for dialogue with BH and potential for amnesty during a media appearance
 - Deby was upbeat about the MNJTF but less optimistic about the Nigerian military
 - UK Chief of Defense Staff was in Nigeria
 - General Rodriguez trip to Nigeria, Niger and Cameroon
 - Agreement that Buhari is saying all the right things
 - UK and France have not received a new wishlist from the Nigerians, so they are still
 operating on the list that was distributed to the G7 this summer
 - P3 agreed that Nigerian December deadline to defeat BH is unrealistic and perhaps dangerous
 - o UK is looking to establish some type of presence in Maiduguri
 - o The UK said that ONSA will chair two committees
 - Defense procurement corruption
 - Human rights abuses
 - Agreement that Nigeria needs to provide public security and justice as first steps in stabilization
 - o Discussed lack of defections policy in Nigeria and LCB countries, and how P3 can support
 - UK has also heard about Nigerian Operation Safe Corridor, but was also somewhat unclear exactly what it entails and how P3 can support
 - Discussed what operationalization of the MNJTF really looks like in P3's view and how MNJTF members view it
 - French reiterated that CCL is not a permanent structure, but the MNJTF has not yet taken up the roles that the CCL is conducting
 - CCL is not ready to dissolve or be folded into the MNJTF
 - Discussion of humanitarian situation
